Consent to Disclosure of Tax Return Information Under IRC Section 7216 Disclosure Consent Requirements

If you consent to this disclosure, federal law may not safeguard your tax return information from further use or distribution. This consent is entirely voluntary; however, E-Commerce.One may decline to provide services or modify service terms if you choose not to sign this form. If you agree, your consent will remain valid for 12 months.

By providing consent, your tax return information, including personally identifiable details such as your SSN or ITIN, may be disclosed to a tax return preparer located outside the United States. Both the U.S.-based tax preparer disclosing your information and the international tax preparer receiving it comply with data protection and security measures under 26 U.S.C. Section 7216 to ensure privacy and prevent unauthorized access to your tax return information.

If you consent to this disclosure, U.S. federal agencies may not have jurisdiction to enforce U.S. laws protecting the privacy of your tax return information against an international tax preparer.
